

In addition, the committee is now officially defunct with no date for their review of the added changes made to the recycling program. Commissioner Sue Carlson made the motion to have the committee meet again in a year for an annual review, but it was not seconded. I believe his personal prejudice against me adversely affected the outcome of the committee's recommendations, undermining my ability as chair to have my report given fair and impartial consideration.

Benefit

The evidence provided here documents Pritchard's motives to control and bully others to have things his way. He has been bent on ridding his territory of anyone who opposes him. This corrupt use of his official position to benefit his campaign is inconsistent with the proper performance of public duty.

Betraying the public trust

Therefore, I am requesting that Pritchard be investigated for not following the standards of conduct per 112.313 (6), specifically, that he has used the official position with which he has been entrusted 1) at commission meetings and 2) on the county website to 3) promote his own personal campaign agenda and 4) benefit himself by prejudicing statements and emails against others and 5) threaten me via an inordinate number of emails to the property appraiser's office intent on raising my taxes and (6) criticize me in my role as chair of the RCAC when he lacked the authority as an individual commission member to do so.

These elements indicate that Ron Pritchard breached the public trust (Art. 2, Sect. 8, FL Constitution) and acted with wrongful intent and in a manner inconsistent with the proper performance of his public duties. (Gordon v. State Com'n on Ethics, 609 So. 2d, 127, 17 Fla. L Weekly D (Fla. App, 4 Dist. Nov. 25, 1992) (No. 91-0202)
